How to enter your dog and earn AKC TITLES:

Your dog must first earn a Junior Courser (JC) title, unless he is already. CHECK EVENT TYPE "TEST" AND STAKES "JC" ON THE ENTRY FORM AND PAY THE FEE FOR JC TEST.

If your dog has practiced successfully with other dogs and has already earned is JC title, you should enter him in Open and compete for the Senior Courser (SC) title. CHECK EVENT TYPE "TRIAL" AND STAKES "OPEN" ON THE ENTRY FORM AND PAY THE ENTRY FEE FOR OPEN.

To earn the SC title, the hound must run with at least one other hound, and must receive qualifying scores at four (4) AKC trials under two different judges or judging panels. At the same time your dog is competing for his SC title, any points earned count towards his Field Championship title. To earn a Field Championship (Fch) - Prefix to a hound's name, your hound must obtain 15 points and must have two first placements worth three points or more under two different judges or judging panels. At least one point must be earned in competition with a hound of the same breed. Please see points schedule below.

A dog who has earned his Field Championship, should be entered in the Field Champion Stake.

If your dog receives qualifying scores in 25 trials, he earns his Master Courser (MC) title.

ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds and Whippets, that are one year of age or older may be entered. All entries must be individually registered with the AKC, an AKC recognized foreign registry, or have an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) from the AKC.

COURSES OFFERED

Junior Courser - Open to all eligible hounds. A hound running alone shall receive certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge on a later date stating that the hound completed a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm without interruption. The two runs can be on the same date at or in conjunction with a National Breed Specialty.

Open—Open to all hounds of a breed that have obtained one of the following: 1) AKC Junior Courser Title 2) AKC Field Champion of Record of that breed may be entered. Hounds that are disqualified (or dismissed within six trials) from field trials may not be entered. *It is recommended that Junior Courser hounds entering the open stake for the first time have successful practice experience with other hounds before competing..*

Specials Stake— Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship title. No Championship points will be awarded in this stake.

Veteran Stake - Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and meet age requirement for a Veteran as established in the Breed's parent club. Championship points will be awarded.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

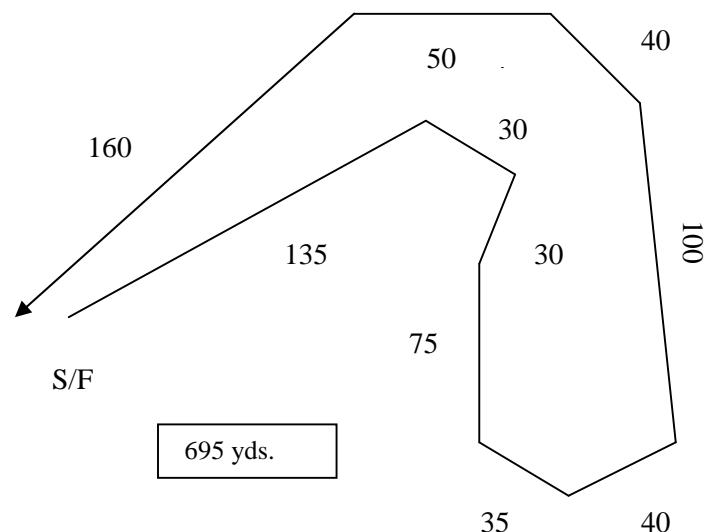
Hounds must be one year of age or older on the day of the test/trial. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused, and the entry fee refunded . Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto test grounds. Hounds NOT PRESENT at time of Roll Call WILL BE SCRATCHED after a five minute grace period. All hounds will be examined for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) are eligible to participate. Monorchid or cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. A battery-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used; backup equipment is available. Lure will consist of white plastic strips. **Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judges, and handlers of the hounds running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.** Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the trial grounds by the Field Trial Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.

FINES

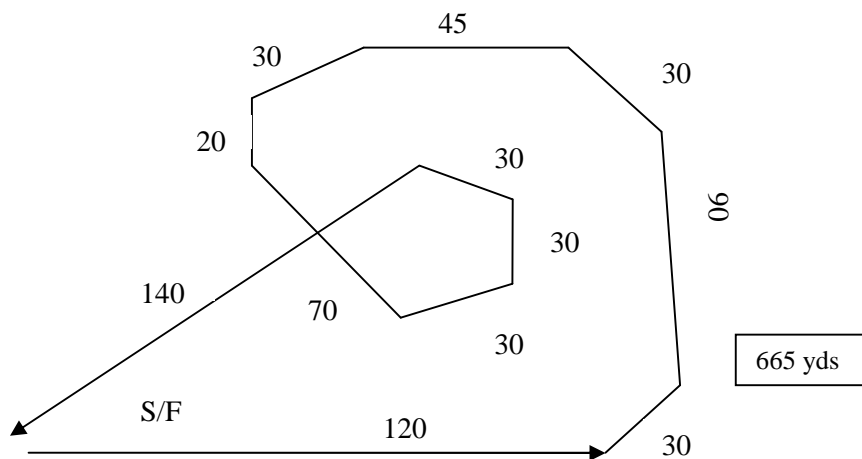
There will be a \$5.00 fine for any loose hound on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
